

## HOW TO CURRENTLY SHOP AT LOCH ARTHUR

- Face coverings are no longer mandatory in Scotland, but the government's recommendation is to still wear them in busy and enclosed spaces. Lots of vulnerable people live and work here at Loch Arthur.
- We continue to practice enhanced cleaning throughout the shop and café. Hand sanitiser is still available for your use at the entrances to the shop and café.
- We are no longer limited entrance numbers, and we have re-introduced wicker baskets as well as trolleys.

- Our café is open. Access is still via the gate on the right-hand side of the shop entrance. We can also offer a takeaway service.
- Our customer toilets are currently only accessible from the garden entrance.
